## Drone and Survey Teams

Drone and survey support using aerial technology for inspection, monitoring and information gathering in high-risk environments. The company positions this service as a way to obtain real-time operational data while reducing direct exposure of personnel to hazards.

## TV and Film Safety

Safety support for productions undertaking filming, stunts, transport or other activity on water. The aim is to reduce risk for cast and crew while enabling the production to maintain its creative goals and operational tempo.



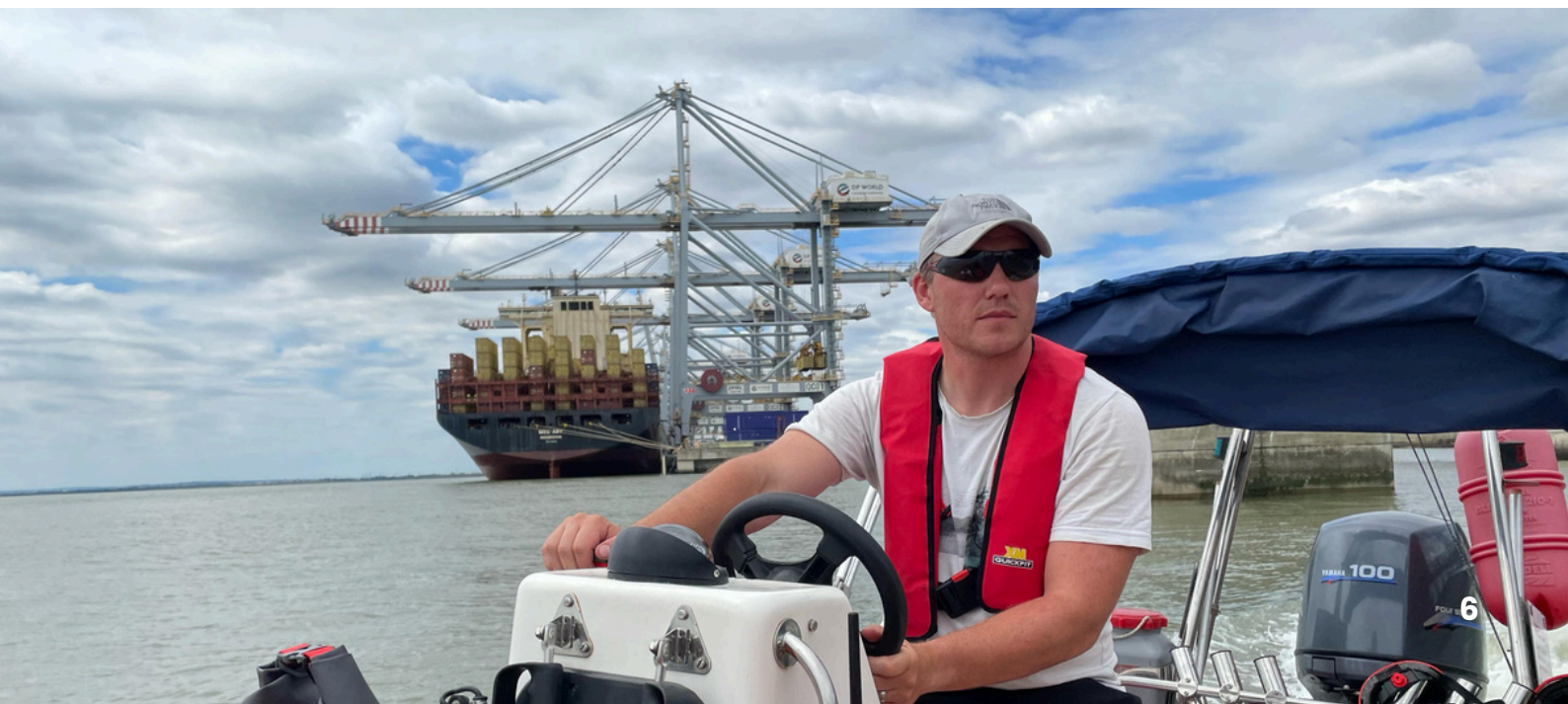

## What sets us apart.

One of the things that sets us apart is that we are Port of London Authority (PLA) coded. This means we are operating with a fully qualified, compliant and insured workboat standard for the River Thames, giving our clients added confidence in both our capability and our professionalism.

Achieving PLA coding is a high-level endorsement that requires extensive checks, standards and ongoing compliance. It is not simply a label. It reflects that the vessel has met strict requirements around safety, suitability, equipment, documentation and operational readiness to work on the Thames.

For our clients, this means reassurance that they are working with a provider that takes standards seriously. It demonstrates that our boats are fit for purpose, properly assessed and backed by the level of compliance expected for professional commercial work on one of the UK's busiest and most demanding waterways.



# Where this matters most.



Where works are being carried out on, over or adjacent to the water, duty holders have a legal responsibility to ensure that risks are properly assessed and that suitable marine control measures are in place. This includes having appropriate access, rescue capability, supervision and operational support where the nature of the task and environment require it.

If the correct marine provision is not in place, clients may be exposed not only to increased operational risk, but also to significant legal and regulatory scrutiny following an incident. In many marine settings, informal arrangements or minimal cover are unlikely to demonstrate that reasonably practicable measures were taken to protect those involved.

## Who we work with.

RTT Marine Operations supports organisations that need specialist marine safety capability or water-based operational support and do not want to compromise on professionalism, safety standards or responsiveness. These include;
